The frumious Bandersnatch!”

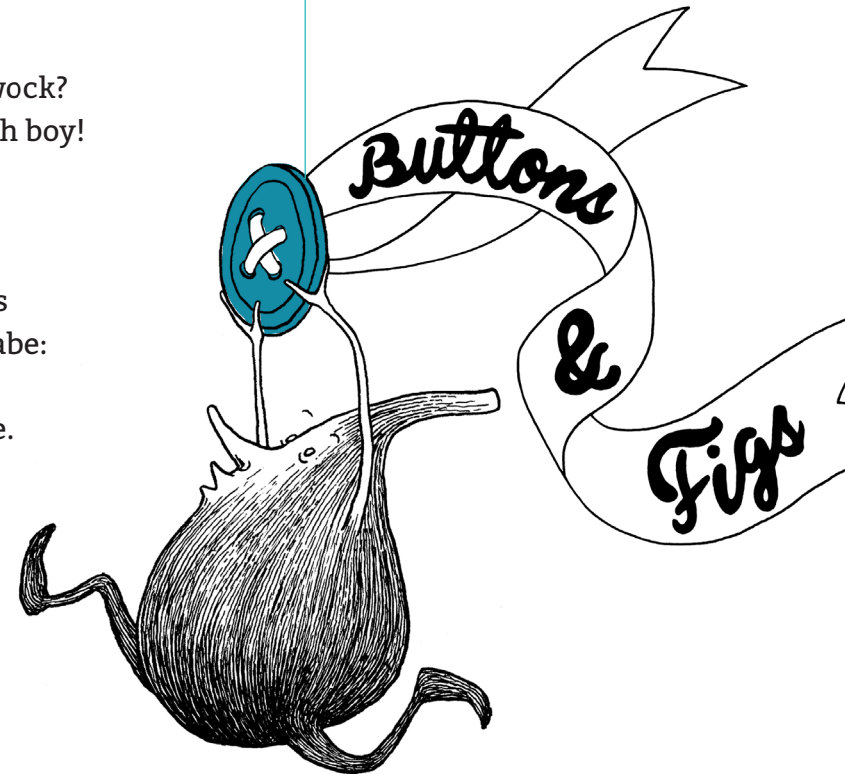
He took his vorpal sword in hand;
