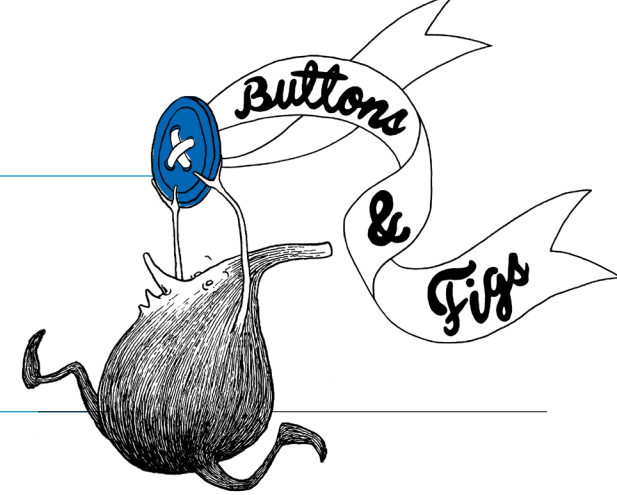


The Jumblies by Edward Lear
